Additional Information

Children will need to bring a packed lunch each day, including a drink. We have a vending machine with snacks and beverages if you would like to send money for additional snacks/drinks.

Long hair should be pulled up in a ponytail. It is also advised to bring a hat and sunscreen.

Jeans or riding pants and a t-shirt will need to be worn for riding but they may bring a change of clothes for other activities. No tank tops please.

Closed-toe shoes such as tennis shoes or paddock boots need to be worn at all times.

No flip flops or sandals allowed.

Riders will also be required to wear an ASTM approved equestrian helmet when riding. We supply helmets that your child may use, or you can bring your own.

Please be sure to drop your child off **at 9 a.m.** as camp will start shortly after. Pickup is **at 1 p.m.** so please plan ahead!

Activities Include

Horse safety, riding, equine education, grooming and tacking up, trail rides, horse nutrition and care, arts & crafts, games and horse show basics.

Horse Show

Riders will show off their skills and participate in a Camp Horse Show on the last day of camp. Starting at **11 a.m.** students will begin tacking up their ponies. The horse show will begin promptly at **11:45 a.m.** Please feel free to come between **11-11:30** to see what your child has learned, and bring a cheering section and your camera!
